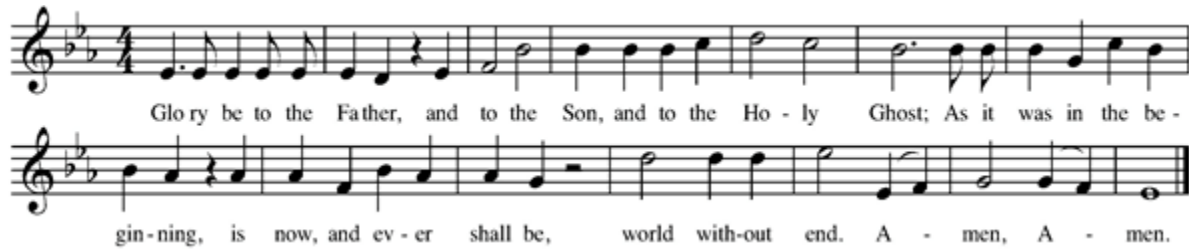
***SILENT CONFESSION**
